



Discuss Data Preparation Grants

Discuss Data offers grants to support the preparation of open access Data Collections for publication on the Discuss Data platform (<https://discuss-data.net/>).

Eligible are Data Collections which belong to one of the curated topics of the Discuss Data platform (in case of doubts consult with the [responsible curator](#)). It is a precondition for any grant application that the respective data collection (or large parts of it) can be published open access on Discuss Data.

The grant has two forms:

(1) The **Discuss Data grants** cover expenses of up to 1,000 EUR related to the cleaning and preparation of a Data Collection for open access (e.g. scanning documents, anonymizing interviews, adding metadata) *and* for the preparation of accompanying detailed data description ("[Documentation of Data Collection](#)").

The grant application should be no longer than one page and provide concise information on (1 paragraph each):

- the topic and content of the data collection
- the relevance of the data collection for research on the topic
- the steps needed to prepare the data collection for upload
- the requested budget with a short justification

(2) The **Hans Koschnick Scholarships** provide support for a stay of two to four weeks at the [Research Centre for East European Studies at the University of Bremen](#). This stay can be used to prepare a Data Collection for upload on the Discuss Data platform in consultation with the [Discuss Data team](#). The stay is supported with a travel allowance of 500 EUR (300 EUR if travelling from Germany), as well as a living allowance of up to 500 EUR for a maximum stay of four weeks.

Due to covid-19 related travel restrictions applications are currently not possible.
