






2. Now you are automatically redirected to the [DARIAH Authentication Authorisation Infrastructure](#) (AAI). If your institution is part of the [eduGAIN](#) network, you can register with your institutional account: Just type the name of your institution into the search box (search can take a few seconds), choose your institution and click “select”.


